guide to organizing  
printed photos

1. Pick a year to start, If unsure start with oldest pictures. Separate by years if possible



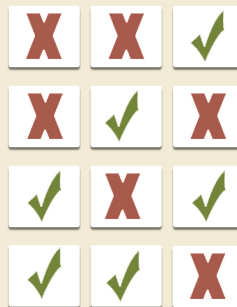
2. Now take the group of pictures from a single year and separate by month.



3. Now focus on a the pictures in a particular month. What are the important events or moments you want to remember.



4. In each event and go through photos of that event. Which photos tell the best story? Which shots best captures the moments of the event? Separate the keepers from the discards.



4a. if you want to keep duplicates for children or family place these in a separate box marked as such

5. Place saved photos in an album of your choice and/or scan to preserve and share



Discarded photos should be the photos that don't add to the story you are telling. They may be blurry or repetitive or dark.
